**Become a sponsoring union – take on
an Organising Works trainee.**

Hoes does it work?

We will advertise and encourage people to apply to the program. We will encourage people from diverse parts of our community, in particular persons from communities that unions are looking to organise, the Nepalese or Indian community for example. As a union joining the program you will have the opportunity to interview the applicants, and appoint, if you felt they would be a good fit for your union.

We are also encouraging unions who have delegates, leading and building power in their workplaces to apply to the program.

Once you have taken that step to appoint a trainee-organiser with your union. The Organising Works unit will then provide the development.

Organising Works Development

The program delivers a mix of face-to-face education and training, study groups, online sessions and a real on the ground campaign environment. This development has been organised over 4 terms. And will consist of 3 weeklong face-to-face education events, bi-weekly online sessions, mentoring and ongoing support.

Additional Support

The development of an Organising Works trainees is only possible through the coordinated support of the union, the union mentor, the Organising Works unit, and a peer support network. Getting this right is crucial to the success of the trainees development, that's why we will run regular training, briefings and information sessions for the union mentor.
